"Man fully alive is the glory of God." This statement of the early church fathers will be explored and demonstrated.

Dr. Newton is a professor of Theology and chair of theology at Franciscan University's Austria Program. He is an associate member of faculty at Maryvale Institute in Birmingham, U.K., and founding member of the Aquinas Institute of Ireland. He is originally from England.
