Theological Foundations of the Catholic Faith

Fr. Joseph Waters will present a systematic overview of the fundamental theological underpinnings of Catholic Doctrine. Students will be led to survey the Catholic understanding of Divine Revelation, the central mysteries of the Nicene Creed, (Trinity, Christology, Pneumatology, Mariology, Ecclesiology); the Sacramentality of the Church, Christ Centered morality, and Christian Prayer. The goal of the Course is laying the foundation of a systematic approach to theological study and reflection.

Dr. Alan Schreck is a Professor Emeritus of Theology at Franciscan University of Steubenville. He has been a professor of theology at Franciscan University of Steubenville since 1978. During this time, he has served as director of Graduate Theology and as chair of the Departments of Theology and Philosophy. Dr Schreck specializes in church history and renewal, (including St. Francis of Assisi), Catholic doctrine and apologetics, pneumatology, ecclesiology, the teachings of the Second Vatican Council and of Pope St. John Paul II. He has authored numerous books beginning with Catholic and Christian: An Explanation of Commonly Misunderstood Catholic Beliefs (Franciscan Media, 1984) and a young adult version of that book.
